On March 27, 2014, the Planning Commission conducted a duly noticed public hearing at regularly scheduled meeting to consider the draft report "Evaluating the Planning Code's Medical Cannabis Dispensaries Locational Requirements." At that hearing, the Planning Commission voted to adopt the report and forward it to the Board of Supervisors. The final report with its recommendations and exhibits are attached to this transmittal.

The attached report was prepared in response to an Ordinance (BF 130734), introduced by Supervisor Avalos on July 16, 2013, and passed into law on November 27, 2013, which directs the Planning Commission to prepare and submit a report to the Board of Supervisors evaluating the provisions of the Planning Code related to the location of medical cannabis dispensaries by May 1, 2014.

The report was determined not to be a project per State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15060(c)(2). Please find attached documents relating to the actions of the Commissions.
