




Planning Code Section 169

Codifies the legal framework, applicability, exemptions, timing requirements, etc.

Effective by BOS March 19, 2017



AMENDING THE PROGRAM STANDARDS

SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENTS

Subject to Planning Commission Approval only.

MINOR AMENDMENTS

Can be approved by Planning Director or designee. Not subject to Planning Commission Approval.

AMENDMENTS CAN INCLUDE:

- The addition or removal of TDM measures
- Adjustment of definitions, points, or monitoring and reporting actions
- Corrections to text references and clarifying implementation requirements

SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENDTS

- "Limited TDM Plan" for Low-Density Development Projects
- Remove PKG-1 (Unbundled Parking) for Non-residential Uses
 - Reduces Overall Base Target for Land Use Category B (Office)
- Changes to Minimum Rates for PKG-2 (Short-term Daily Parking) 3.
- Clarifications to Development Projects Constructed in Multiple Phases 4.
- Clarifications to INFO-1 (Multimodal Wayfinding Signage) 5.
- 6. Changes to ACTIVE-2 (Bicycle Parking)
